

Attacks Targeting Turkish Citizens Abroad in 2019



INTRODUCTION

As the first two decades of the 21st century come to a close, we can see that the world as whole has not performed well in terms of humanitarian values. Globally, hostility towards Islam is rising at an alarming rate, from the anti-Muslim attacks in Western countries and India, to the horrors of the Rohingya Genocide in Myanmar. The Islamophobic sentiment prompted by the Western media hasn't just pushed the socio-political balance of Western countries towards the far right, it has also made Muslim minorities open targets for abuse everywhere. These anti-Muslim abuses and attacks are made possible by the fact that perpetrators are aware they will not provoke much international public outrage.

Though its history goes back much further, the adoption and normalization of Islamophobia in Western countries can be traced to the 9/11 terrorist attacks and the subsequent military interventions in Afghanistan, Iraq, and Syria. These events, coupled with recent terrorist attacks in major European cities and the humanitarian crisis caused by the influx of Syrian refugees, has created a breeding ground for anti-Muslim sentiment and led to Islamophobia being the new normal in Western countries.

Despite the serious casualties caused by racists and Islamophobic attacks in the last twenty years, such as the racist NSU murders in Germany where 10 people were killed, these attacks are often still treated as individual cases and their organizational links are left unscrutinized. In reality, we have reached a point where this anti-Muslim terrorism requires a global effort to put an end to such violence.

The followings are a few examples of violent Islamophobic terror attacks that have happened across the world in the last three years: the Finsbury Park Mosque Attack in London where 1 person was killed and twelve were injured by an attack in a van, the mass shooting at the Quebec City Islamic Culture Center in Canada where 6 people lost their lives and 18 were injured during evening prayers, the New Years Eve 2019 vehicle attack in the Ruhr region of Germany where 4 were killed and more than 20 were injured, the Christchurch mass shootings in New Zealand where two mosques were targeted and 49 people were killed and 20 were injured, and the shooting of two cafes owned by residents of Turkish descent in Hanau, Germany, in which 9 people (4 of them were Turkish) died and 2 were wounded.

Racist and Islamophobic hate speech by some public officials and politicians in Western countries has played a major role in promoting such violent acts. The European Commission against Racism and Intolerance (ECRI) found in their 2020 Germany Report¹ that public opinion has become increasingly xenophobic and that rising anti-Islam trends are alarming— in part thanks to German Federal Minister of the Interior Horst Seehofer's 2018 statement: "Islam does not belong to Germany".

From verbal harassment on the street to physical attacks on Muslim centers and houses of worship, any kind of Islamophobic abuse not taken seriously further reinforce the perception that racist and anti-Muslim terrorism is acceptable— i.e. that it receives social and institutional support.

Thus, statistically, Muslims are among the most discriminated minority groups in Europe today. For example, according to data from the French Interior Ministry², there were 154 recorded cases of attacks against Muslims in 2019, of which 63 were physical and verbal assaults, while 91 were threats. In addition, the Collective Against Islamophobia in France (CCIF) found that anti-Muslim incidents showed an 18% increase compared to the previous year, with 59% of the 789 cases recorded being discrimination, 9% racism and 32% hate crime³.

Data from the Swiss Federal Commission against Racism (FCR) also reveals that racist attacks across the country increased by 27%, from 278 in 2018 to 352 in 2019. Of these 352 cases, 55 were recorded as Islamophobic and 132 as racist cases against predominantly Muslim immigrants.⁴

The Dutch National Discrimination Report⁵, prepared by the instructions of the Dutch Ministry of Interior and the Police Service, stated that the religious-based discrimination increased by 30%. Furthermore, the Dutch Social and Cultural Planning Agency (SCP) report⁶ on discrimination found that that one-third of Muslims in the Netherlands experienced discrimination in 2019. It was also reported that 57% of Turkish citizens definitely faced discrimination and 71% of them faced incidents which were "probably" discrimination.

According to German Bundestag records⁷, there have been 550 attacks targeting mosques between 2001 and 2019, while the number of mosque attacks recorded in 2019 alone is 110.⁸ In addition to the fact that in previous years anti-Muslim were not officially recorded as a separate category, it should be noted that mosque associations and citizens avoided reporting attacks to the police, so the statistics may not accurately reflect the frequency and severity of attacks.

That being said, statistics play an important role in mobilizing national authorities and raising international public opinion. The cooperation of all countries in the fight against Islamophobic terrorism, which has become a global issue, can only be made possible by proving the extent and broadness of the problem.

With this in mind, the Presidency for Turks Abroad and Related Communities prepares the "Attacks Against Turkish Citizens Abroad" report on an annual basis. The purpose of this report is to record and present the attacks against settled Turkish communities in Europe, North America, and Australia, as they are reported in the media, or through the victims themselves who file reports to our Presidency.

⁷ https://bundestag.de/drucksache ⁸ https://brandeilig.org/ This report, which is shared with our public institutions, politicians, and foreign stakeholders, aims to raise awareness of the importance of victims informing authorities by showing the prevalence of racist incidents, as well as the necessity of officials in positions of power taking internationally reaching measures to combat such incidents. Last year's report recorded 128 attacks on Turkish citizens living abroad in 2018, while the number of Islamophobic and racist attacks as a whole recorded by our Presidency increased by 137% to 303 in 2019. Of these 303 attacks, 50 targeted Muslims who were not of Turkish origin, while 253 directly or indirectly targeted Turkish citizens. The 137% increase in recorded cases should not be viewed as a sudden spike but as a reflection of the rising awareness of reporting such attacks by our citizens, NGOs, local media, and partner institutions.

Later sections of this report will provide analysis and details of the attacks recorded in 2019.




ATTACKS TARGETING TURKISH CITIZENS ABROAD IN 2019

f the 253 attacks targeting Turkish citizens abroad in 2019, 47 were related to the PKK terrorist organization while the remaining 206 were Islamophobic or xenophobic in nature. There will be a detailed assessment of PKK terrorism related attacks targeting Turkish citizens in the final portion of this report in a separate section.

Apart from the PKK terrorism related attacks, we can see that the motivation behind 126 out of 206 attacks were Islamophobic while the remaining 80 were racist. Below is graphic expressing this difference in motivation of such attacks.



Distribution of Attacks Targeting Turkish Citizens Abroad in terms of Motivation

In terms of distribution by country, the largest proportion of attacks (58.9% of 253) on Turkish citizens, as registered by the YTB in 2019, took place in Germany where the Turkish population is most concentrated. The top 5 countries where Turkish citizens were attacked the most were Germany, France, Switzerland, the United Kingdom and the Netherlands, respectively. The numerical distribution of attacks by country is as follows:



The proportional distribution between countries is as follows:


Proportional Distribution of Attacks Targeting Turkish Citizens Abroad by Countries



If we look at the types of attacks that targeted our citizens abroad in 2019, they can be classified as verbal or physical in nature. Of the attacks targeting Turkish citizens in 2019, 66,9% of registered cases were physical attacks. Verbal attacks on Turkish citizens— which, to be more clear, are attacks that do not have physical consequences and include targeting morale through hate speech on social media or daily life, flag burning, leaving severed pig heads, hoax bomb calls, and letters of threat— constitute about 33% of all attacks. In addition to verbal attacks, the other 170 physical attacks on Turkish citizens abroad can be classified as follows in the table below:

As we can see from the table above, mosques are targeted the most, making up 64 of 170 physical attacks. Considering that mosques are also often the targets of hate speech, verbal threats, hoax bomb calls, severed pig heads, and letters of threat we can safely concede that they are the most vulnerable targets when it comes to hate crimes.



If we take a closer look at the top five countries where the most attacks occurred, we can see that Germany leads with the most attacks motivated by Islamophobia (73 out of 149). The rest of the attacks in Germany were motivated by racism (52) or related to the PKK terrorist organization (24). Below is the graphic expressing this distribution.



The second country where the most attacks occurred after Germany is France, which has the second-largest Turkish population. Of the 25 attacks on Turkish citizens in France, 12 were Islamophobic, 8 were racist, and 5 were caused by the PKK terrorist organization.

Distribution of Attacks on Turkish Citizens in France by Motivation






When the attacks against Turkish citizens in France were evaluated according to their targets, the most common type of attack was assault against a person. Below is a table expressing the number of attacks and types.


Distribution of Attacks Targeting Turkish Citizens in France by Type





Despite only having the ninth largest Turkish population, Switzerland has the third most recorded attacks against Turkish citizens after France and Germany. Of the 15 attacks against Turkish citizens in Switzerland, 6 were racist, 6 were Islamophobic, and 3 were caused by the PKK terrorist organization.


Distribution of Attacks on Turkish Citizens in Switzerland by Motivation






When the attacks against Turkish citizens in Switzerland were evaluated in terms of their targets, the most common type of attack was hate speech and verbal threat. The ECRI 2020 Switzerland Report revealed that while discrimination against Muslims in Switzerland are at the forefront, most of the cases of abuse were carried out through social media. Below is a table and graph expressing the number of attacks and types.


Distribution of Attacks Targeting Turkish Citizens in Switzerland by Type





The United Kingdom, the country with the eighth largest Turkish population, has the fourth the most attacks on Turkish citizens. Of the 15 attacks on Turkish citizens in the UK, 10 were Islamophobic, 2 were racist, and 3 were caused by the PKK terrorist organization.






When the attacks against Turkish citizens in the United Kingdom were evaluated according to their targets, the most common type of attack was hate speech and threat, the same as Switzerland. Below is a table and graph expressing the number of attacks and types.

Distribution of Attacks Targeting Turkish Citizens in the United Kingdom by Type






The Netherlands, which has the third largest Turkish population, has the fifth highest number of attacks against Turkish citizens. All 10 attacks on Turkish citizens in the Netherlands were Islamophobic motivated attacks.

Distribution of Attacks on Turkish Citizens in the Netherlands by Motivation

When the attacks against Turkish citizens in the Netherlands are evaluated according to their targets, the most common type of attack in the Netherlands is attack against mosque (8). The other 2 attacks are hate speech and threat.



Although the motivation and types of attacks differ across the top five countries, the overall picture illustrates that the main motivation for hate crimes against Turkish citizens in 2019 was predominantly Islamophobia. In connection with this motivation, mosques have been targeted the most in attacks against Turkish citizens abroad in 2019. For this reason it is critical that we raise awareness amongst our mosque administrators and the communities that they serve, and encourage increased security measures, communication, and cooperation with the local authorities.



Another common type of attack against Turkish citizens living abroad is hate speech and verbal threats, which can occur in daily life or online through social media. Even if these attacks do not turn physical, our citizens must still report and pursue legal action against any form of hate speech, threats, or verbal abuse which they encounter (whether it be in daily life or online).

However, this is not to say that hate crimes are in any way easy to face; it is an undeniable fact that hate crimes take a toll on one's psychological and economic well being. For this reason there needs to be civil initiatives that make reporting such crimes easier and also provide both psychological and legal support to victims.

In Germany (which holds the record for most attacks against Turkish citizens), the ECRI 2020 Germany Report criticizes the Federal Anti-Discrimination Agency (Antidiskriminierungsstelle des Bundles) for lacking basic support measures for victims whose rights were violated, and for failing to help victims find justice through the judiciary system. It also emphasizes that there is no public anti-discrimination structure at the state-level, which should be the primary authority within the scope of internal affairs to deal with such matters. To bridge this gap, it would be helpful for civil society to take a more active role in these matters.

In the next part of the report, attacks targeting Turkish citizens abroad will be presented in chronological order.



ATTACKS TARGETING TURKISH CITIZENS ABROAD IN CRONOLOGICAL ORDER

GERMANY / January 1 IGMG MEVLANA MOSQUE - Duisburg

Racist and insulting slogans were written on the walls of the Mevlana Mosque (affiliated with Islamic Community Milli Görüş (IGMG)). The "Star of David" symbol was painted on the wall of the mosque as well.

GERMANY / January 6

ATTACK ON TURKISH EDUCATION CENTER - Dortmund

The Dortmund Turkish Education Center was attacked twice: on 30.12.2018 and 06.01.2019. The valuable items were not touched, but the doors were damaged as a result someone trying to kick them open (they were locked), all the files in the cabinets were scattered, and the mailbox was damaged. For both incidents, the attacker/attackers targeted only the Education Center; no damage was done to the other associations located upstairs.

FRANCE / January 7 ATTACK ON TURKISH CULTURAL ASSOCIATION - Amboise

The Turkish Cultural Association was defaced by an unidentified person or persons who drew swatstikas on the walls.

UNITED KINGDOM / January 7 HATE SPEECH - Birmingham

Pro-Nazi, racist, and anti-Muslim graffiti was found in Birmingham.

GERMANY / January 7

DITIB BAD SACKINGEN MİMAR SINAN MOSQUE -Bad Sackingen

Letters containing profanity and insults were sent to the Bad Sackingen Mimar Sinan Mosque (affiliated with the Turkish-Islamic Union for Religious Affairs (DITIB)).

UNITED KINGDOM / January 9 HATE SPEECH

A far-right protester urged officials to ban Islam in England and force Muslims to "collectively return back".

GERMANY / January 10

DITIB FATIH MOSQUE - Baden-Baden

An e-mail containing an insult towards Islam was sent to Fatih Mosque (affiliated with Turkish-Islamic Union for Religious Affairs (DITIB)). Also, a letter with similar content was sent to the mosque in 2018 as well.

SWITZERLAND / January 11

ITDV FATIH MOSQUE - Solothurn

A paint attack was carried out on the Anadolu-Helvetia Fatih Mosque, which is affiliated with the Swiss Turkish Religious Foundation (ITDV), by 3 unidentified people. Police officers who examined the security camera records stated that the attackers entered the building's garden without permission and as such the crime would be evaluated and reported as a "violation of residence immunity" instead of as a "hate crime".

GERMANY / January 14 THREAT LETTER TO TURKISH ATTORNEY - Frankfurt

Seda Başay Yıldız, one of the joint attorneys in the NSU case, was sent a second threat letter with the signature "NSU 2.0".

GERMANY / January 24 ATTACK ON DITIB HOHENLIMBURG MOSQUE - Hagen

An unidentified, masked person entered the Hohenlimburg Mosque (affiliated with Turkish-Islamic Union for Religious Affairs (DITIB)). No physical damage to the mosque was found.

FRANCE / January 26

THE RACIST SPEECH FROM FRENCH SENATOR - Paris

This tweet from French senator Esther Benbassa about President Recep Tayyip Erdogan received a lot of attention on social media. Just after the senator mentioned Maduro, who was faced with the coup attack in Venezuela, she asked: "When will Erdogan's turn come?

GERMANY / January 27 DITIB CENTRAL FATIH MOSQUE - Essen-Müllheim

An unidentified person threatened to bomb the Central Fatih Mosque in Mülheim an der Ruhr, which is affiliated with Turkish-Islamic Union for Religious Affairs (DITIB), by phone.

DITIB GREEN MOSQUE - Menden

The Menden Green Mosque, affiliated with the Turkish-IslamicUnion for Religious Affairs (DITIB), was attacked. It was determined that the attackers broke through the glass at the entrance of the mosque and wanted to set fire by igniting paper towels in the washroom.

UNITED KINGDOM / January 29 HATE SPEECH TO STUDENTS - London

A person used racist and Islamophobic slurs in a video he took of Muslim girls on their way to school and posted this on the social media. He was eventually arrested.

GERMANY / February 2

RACIST ATTACK ON ISBANK BRANCH - Berlin

The windows and walls of the IsBank branch in Berlin were damaged in a paint attack.

UNITED KINGDOM / February 6 HATE SPEECH ON SOCIAL MEDIA

Conservative Member of the Parliament Mike Franklin was removed from office because of his Islamophobic tweets.

GERMANY / February 12

ATTACK ON TURKISH WORKPLACE - Lünen

Unidentified persons entered a workplace in Lünen that belonged to Turksih citizen Fatma İ. and Kosovan citizen Jasmina B. They broke the windows and drew swastika on the walls and mirrors.

BULGARIA / February 12 ATTACK ON PLEVNE MOSQUE - Pleven

An unidentified person had written "Isa Ekber" on the wall of the Pleven Mosque (Çiftekahve Mosque).

ITDV FATIH MOSQUE - Solothurn

Three posters with the words "Foreigners out", "Leftists to concentration camps", "Attack the leftists in Bern" were hung on the building that had been purchased to be used for the Anadolu-Helvetia Fatih Mosque, which is affiliated with Swiss Turkish Religious Foundation (ITDV), by unidentified people. These posters were then removed by police.

GERMANY / February 16 DITIB CENTRAL MOSQUE - Kehl

Unidentified persons threw stones at the windows of the Central Mosque Kehl, which is affiliated with Turkish-Islamic Union for Religious Affairs (DITIB), at midnight and pecuniary damage occurred.

FRANCE / February 21 HATE SPEECH AT A STORE - Mandelieu-la-Napoule

A headscarf-wearing woman working at a H&M store was insulted by a client who said: "I do not want to get service from a headscarf-wearing woman. You shouldn't be here." Mayor Henri Leroy wrote a letter to the store management and asked for the woman to be dismissed.

GERMANY / February 24

ARMED ATTACK AGAINST A TURKISH RESTAURANT -Rosenheim

An armed attack was carried out on a restaurant located under the Rosenheim Mosque (which is affiliated with the Turkish-Islamic Union for Religious Affairs (DITIB)). Minor pecuniary damage occurred in the mosque.

GERMANY / February 24 ATTACK ON TURKISH RESTAURANT - Rosenheim

Another Turkish doner shop was attacked with a gun following an attack on February 24 in Rosenheim and minor damage occurred.



FRANCE / March 3

ARMED ATTACK ON YOUNG TURKISH GIRL - Saône-et-Loire

In the clash between rival drug gangs, a 14-year-old Turkish girl who was passing through was shot. The mother of the wounded girl said that her daughter was deliberately targeted.

UNITED KINGDOM / March 4 HATE SPEECH

A Christian preacher who shared anti-Muslim video content was arrested.

GERMANY / March 4

DITIB FATIH MOSQUE - Dresden

The windows of the Fatih Mosque (affiliated with the Turkish-Islamic Union for Religious Affairs (DITIB)) were broken by unidentified attackers. Nobody was physically harmed but pecuniary damage occurred.

FRANCE / March 6 DEATH OF TURKISH TEENAGER - Grenoble

It was alleged that the police were responsible for the traffic accident where 19-yearold Turkish teenager Fatih K. and his friend died.

FRANCE / March 8

HATE SPEECH IN THE WOMEN'S FAIR - Béziers

Morgan Dermarcy, who participated in the women's fair in Béziers to exhibit her products, was removed from the fair hall by the Mayor and his team due her headscarf. Dermarcy reported that she would planned to file an official complaint.

GERMANY / March 17

DITIB THANNHAUSEN MOSQUE - Thannhausen

The gate of the Thannhausen Mosque affilitated with the Turkish-Islamic Union for Religious Affairs (DITIB) was damaged by unidentified attackers.

GERMANY / March 21

DITIB DANNSTADT MOSQUE - Dannstadt

The name of the terrorist who raided the mosque in New Zealand was written and a swastika was drawn on the street-front wall of the Dannstadt Mosque (which is affiliated with the Turkish-Islamic Union for Religious Affairs (DITIB)).

DENMARK / March 22

HATE SPEECH AGAINST MUSLIMS - Copenhagen

The Friday Prayer, held in front of the Danish Parliament to protest terrorist attacks in two mosques in New Zealand where 51 people died, took place under the provocations of extreme right-wingers. Rasmus Paludan, the leader of the antiimmigrant and anti-Islamic Hard Line, tried to provoke the protestors by burning the Quran. The Danish People's Deputy extreme right-wing Martin Henriksen tried to provoke the crowd as well.

GERMANY / March 22

HATE SPEECH IN FRONT OF BACKNANG DITIB MOSQUE -Backnang

A 45-year-old person swore using racist slurs and insulted people at the exit of the Friday prayer in front of the Backnang Mosque (which is affiliated with the Turkish-Islamic Union for Religious Affairs (DITIB)). He also performed the Hitler salute towards the crowd and shouted.

SWITZERLAND / March 25 HATE SPEECH AGAINST MUSLIMS - Basel

On Facebook, the leader of the Basel-based, far-right National Orientierter Schweizer (Pnos) party praised the terrorist attacks in New Zealand and called for a massacre of Muslims, saying: "If only we could be like him, we would win and save our people."

UNITED KINGDOM / March 26 ATTACK ON THE QURAN - Newcastle

The Newcastle Bahr Academy was attacked, and the Quran was torn down and burned.

FRANCE / March 29

DITIB TURKISH CULTURE ASSOCIATON - Bourgoin Jallieu

The mailbox belonging to the Turkish Culture Association, affiliated with the Turkish-Islamic Union for Religious Affairs (DITIB), was broken and a swastika was drawn on it.

BELGIUM / March 29







In the town of Starogard Gdanski, in the city of Gdansk, Murat O. and Furkan K., two Turkish citizens sitting in a cafe with their friends, were threatened by a Polish person who came to their table saying: " I know who you are, leave this place." They departed but had to return to retrieve their mobile phones, which they had forgotten in a rush to leave when the number of attackers increased to 5 people (some of whom held a machete and an axe in their hands). They quickly left the scene afterwards.

RACIST ATTACK ON TURKISH WOMAN - Hannover

AfD members, who participated in a protest march in the city of Hannover, attacked a headscarf- wearing Turkish woman and made derogatory insults. It has also been claimed that the police inflicted physical violence on Turkish woman who was attacked.

A sticker contains hate speech towards immigrants was placed in Norderstedt train station by an unidentified persons. The sticker included an image of a man with beard and glasses and the inscription of "Attention, Pushing Migrants" with a red colored stop sign.

AUSTRALIA / September 7 HATE SPEECH ON SOCIAL MEDIA

A person in NSW was detained due to violent posts about Muslims on Facebook and for planning to attack a mosque. The detainee reported his admiration towards the Christchurch terrorist Brenton Tarrant on his Facebook posts and threatened to kill New Zealand Prime Minister Jacinda Ardern. The 43-year-old detainee planned to attack a mosque and massacre the people inside during the Friday prayer.



THREAT LETTER TO ISLAMIC CULTURAL ASSOCIATION -Stockholm

A letter of threat was sent to the Islamic Cultural Association in Trollhâttan, stating "Leave Sweden immediately or your children will die" and "there will be murders in mosques and outdoor spaces in 26 days."

DITIB LEHRTE SELIMIYE MOSQUE - Hannover

A letter containing insulting statements and pictures about Islam was left in the mailbox of the Lehrte Selimiye Mosque, which is affiliated with Turkish-Islamic Union for Religious Affairs (DITIB).

NETHERLANDS / December 31 ATTACK ON HDV GRAND MOSQUE - Sliedrecht

An arson attempt was made at the Grand Mosque (affiliated with Netherlands Religious Foundation (HDV)) by an unidentified person who tried to set fire by pouring a caustic on the wooden fences while members of the mosque were performing the evening prayer.

ttacks committed by the PKK terrorist organization against Turkish citizens abroad continued in 2019. Against the backdrop of the rising wave of Islamophobic and racist attacks against Muslims and Turkish people, the PKK terrorist organization started targeting more civilians, with 46 attacks in 2018 and 47 in 2019.

Of the 47 attacks the PKK terrorist organization was responsible for in 2019, 38 (80.8%) were carried out in 10 separate countries in Europe in October, right when Turkey's Operation Peace Spring had begun.


Attacks carried out by the PKK terrorist organization were most frequent in Germany (same as other hate crimes/attacks carried out against Turkish citizens). In Germany, 24 attacks were recorded in 2019. The numbers of attacks by countries are as follows:

Distribution of PKK Terrorist Attacks Abroad by Country






Distribution of PKK Terrorist Attacks Abroad by Type

BELGIUM / February 2

ATTACK ON TURKISH CAFE - Anvers

PKK supporters attacked a cafe operated by Turkish citizens in Anvers.

BELGIUM / February 3

ARMED ATTACK ON TURKISH CITIZENS - Anvers

As a result of an armed attack by PKK supporters against three Turkish citizens, one of the Turkish citizens died and two were seriously injured.

UNITED KINGDOM / April 8

ATTACK ON KAHRAMANMARASLILAR ASSOCIATION - London

Kahramanmaraslılar Education and Culture Association was attacked.



GERMANY / June 28 ATTACK ON DITIB CENTRAL MOSQUE - Kassel

"YPG" (an acronym for the PKK terrorist organization) was written on the street-facing walls of the Central Mosque affiliated with the Turkish-Islamic Union for Religious Affairs (DITIB).

FRANCE / October 8

ATTACK ON SUPERMARKET - Paris

"PKK" was written on the market door of the mosque affiliated with Islamic Community Milli Görüş (CIMG)

ITALY / October 10

TERRORIST ATTACK ON FOREIGN MISSION - GENOA

A paint attack was carried out on the Honorary Consulate General of the Republic of Turkey in Genoa.

GERMANY / October 10

ATTACKS ON MOSQUE AND CLUBHOUSE - Bad Salzuflen

The Turkish flag in front of the Mevlâna Mosque, affiliated with the Turkish-Islamic Union for Religious Affairs (DITIB), was stolen and the clubhouse was attacked and damaged. The windows were also broken by a fire extinguisher being thrown at the building.


BELGIUM / October 11 ATTACK ON TURKISH CITIZENS - Liege

Turkish citizens were attacked in Liege.

GERMANY / October 11

VEHICLE ARSON - Berlin

A vehicle belonging to a Turkish citizen was set on fire and destroyed.

GERMANY / October 11

ATTACK ON VEHICLE OF FOREING MISSION - Berlin

A vehicle with a diplomatic plate belonging to Turkish Embassy in Berlin was sabotaged; the vehicle was burned completely and became unusable.

GERMANY / October 11

TERROR ATTACK ON CLINIC - Hamburg

An attack was carried out on a Turkish doctor's clinic in Hamburg.

GERMANY / October 11

ATTACK ON TURKISH YOUTHS - Bochum

A vehicle belonging to young Turkish people, wearing star and crescent t-shirts, was first blocked and then attacked with baseball bats. The vehicle was damaged while the youths managed to escape.

FRANCE / October 12

ATTACK ON TURKISH CITIZENS - Strasbourg

A group, protesting Operation Peace Spring, attacked Turkish citizens with baseball bats.

SWITZERLAND / October 12 HATE EXPRESSION - Basel

Turkish flag was burned in Basel.

SWITZERLAND / October 12

ATTACK ON FOREIGN MISSION - Bern

During an attempt to attack the Turkish Embassy in Bern, police had to use anti-riot vehicles.

ITALY / October 12

ATTACK ON ENTERPRISE - Rome

The Turkish Airlines counter was occupied at Rome Fiumicino Airport and passengers were blocked from passing.

ITALY / October 12

ATTACK ON FOREIGN MISSION - Rome

Anti-Turkey slogans were written on the wall of the Turkish Culture and Tourism Office.

GERMANY / October 12

ATTACK ON TURKISH SUPERMARKET - Nuremberg

Approximately 1.500 people attacked a Turkish market located in the south of Nuremberg. Despite the intervention of the police, the attackers injured market owner Mustafa S. and his son Omer S.

GERMANY / October 12

ATTACK ON TURKISH WORKERS ASSOCIATOIN - Villingen Schweningen

Two people were injured in an attack on the Turkish Workers Association.

GERMANY / October 13

HATE EXPRESSION - Regensburg

The Turkish flag was burned in Regensburg.

FINLAND / October 14

ATTACK ON FOREIGN MISSION - Helsinki

The windows of the building of the Turkish Embassy in Helsinki were broken.

FRANCE / October 14

ATTACK ON THE VEHICLE OF TURKS - Mantes-la-Jolie

Following the France-Turkey football match, there was an attack on a moving vehicle with a Turkish flag.

GERMANY / October 14 ATTACK ON TURKISH KIOSK - Herne

In Herne, 350 people gathered at a PKK terrorist organization protest, attacked a Turkish kiosk, and injured two people.

GERMANY / October 14 ATTACK ON TURKISH CAFE - Herne

In Herne, 350 people gathered at the PKK terrorist organization protest, attacked a Turkish cafe (after attacking the Turkish kiosk) and injured one police officer and one civilian.

GERMANY / October 14 ATTACK ON SPORT CLUB - Pforzheim

An attack with Molotov cocktails was carried out on the Fatihspor Club in Pforzheim and approximately 100.000 euros in damage occurred.

UNITED KINGDOM / October15

ATTACK ON ICMG ASSOCIATION - London

Slogans of terrorist organizations were written on the walls of Islamic Community National-Vision (ICMG) office.

NORTH MACEDONIA / October 15 ATTACK ON HISTORICAL BAZAAR - Skopje

Poster of President Erdogan were defaced with red paint. They hung in one of the shops in the historical Skopje bazaar along with an anti-Turkey banner.

GERMANY / October 15

ATTACK ON DITIB YAVUZ SULTAN SELIM MOSQUE - Offenbach

The walls of Yavuz Sultan Selim Mosque, affiliated with the Turkish-Islamic Union for Religious Affairs (DITIB), were defaced and some item were damaged.

GERMANY / October 15 ATTACK ON A YOUNG GIRL - Stuttgart

Turkish citizen Hatice C., a young girl dressed in a camouflage suit with a crescent and a star, was first verbally and then physically assaulted. Her right eye of the young girl was bruised from a blow.

GERMANY / October 15

ATTACK ON DITIB HERNE MOSQUE - Herne

The windows of the Herne Mosque, affiliated with the Turkish-Islamic Union for Religious Affairs (DITIB), were broken and slogans were chanted in favor of the PKK terrorist organization. After the mosque's doors were closed, the windows of the neighboring Turkish workplaces were broken and buildings were damaged.

FRANCE / October 16

ATTACK ON CONSULATE GENERAL - Lyon

The building of the Consulate General of Turkey in Lyon was defaced with spray paint.

FRANCE / October 16

ATTACK ON CONSULATE GENERAL - Nantes

During an attack against the Consulate General of Turkey in Nantes, terrorismrelated phrases were written on the building's wall. Some of the walls were also painted green and gasoline was poured around the building.



GERMANY / October 16

ATTACK ON DITIB EYUP SULTAN MOSQUE - Liepzig

Eyup Sultan Mosque, affiliated with the Turkish-Islamic Union for Religious Affairs (DITIB) and located in the city of Leipzig, was attacked. Pitch balls were used and the building was damaged.

GERMANY / October 16 KNIFE ATTACK - Lüdenscheid

A German citizen of Turkish descent was stabbed in the back and seriously injured.

GREECE / October 17 ATTACK ON ATATURK HOUSE - Thessaloniki

There was an attempted attack on the Ataturk House, in the garden of the Consulate General of Turkey, in Thessaloniki.

GERMANY / October 17

VEHICLE ARSON - Ludwigsburg

The vehicle of a Turkish citizen living in Ludwigsburg was set on fire.



GERMANY / October 20

ATTACK ON DITIB EVING GRAND MOSQUE - Dortmund

The Eving Grand Mosque, affiliated with the Turkish-Islamic Union for Religious Affairs (DITIB), was attacked with a molotov cocktail. A small fire was started and it caused damage to the mosque.

GERMANY / October 23 ATTACK ON TURKISH COFFEEHOUSE - Herne

A Turkish coffeehouse in Herne was attacked for the second time.

GERMANY / October 25 ATTACK ON TURKISH PASSANGERS - Frankfurt

Supporters of the PKK terrorist organization, who protested at Frankfurt Airport and occupied the Turkish Airlines (THY) transaction box, attacked Turkish passengers.

ITALY / October 26

ATTACK ON CONSULATE GENERAL - Milano

A group gathered in front of the Consulate General of Turkey in Milan, set the area on fire, and attacked the police with fireworks.

NORWAY / October 26 ATTACK ON VEHICLE - Oslo

A vehicle driven by a family retuning from a demonstration of support for Peace Spring Operation was attacked.

ATTACK ON TURKISH AIRLINES AGENCY - Bern

The windows of the authorized Turkish Airlines agency in Bern were broken, and "Crush Turkish Fascism" was written on the walls.

GERMANY / November 7

ATTACK ON DITIB MOSQUE - Ludwigsburg

PKK / YPG was written on the courtyard wall of Ludwigsburg Mosque affiliated with Turkish-Islamic Union for Religious Affairs (DITIB).

GERMANY / November 15 ATTACK ON SULTAN AHMET MOSQUE - Billstedt

"PKK" was written on the windows of the Sultan Ahmet Mosque with spray paint.

GERMANY / November 23

ATTACK ON FOOTBALL CLUB SALES KIOSK - Pforzheim

A wooden sales kiosk on the field side of Pforzheim Fatihspor Football Club was set on fire.

UNITED KINDGOM / December 12 ATTACK ON TURKISH CITIZEN - Leeds

Turkish student Eren B. responded to anti-Turkish propaganda at a booth in the city center in Leeds by stating, "We have no problem with the Kurds, we are fighting the PKK terrorist organization." Five people who said "I am the PKK" physically assaulted Eren B. and destroyed his phone by throwing it to the ground.
